

Conditionals



Name	Form	Time	Function	Example
First Conditional	If + present + comma + will	Present / Future	For actions that are likely to happen. High probability 80% sure	If I <i>finish</i> my tasks on time, I <i>will</i> join you for lunch.
Second Conditional	If + past + comma + would	Present / Future	For actions that are unlikely to happen. Low probability 20% sure	If I <i>had</i> more time, I <i>would</i> do more sport.
Third Conditional	If + had + past participle (3 rd form) + comma + would + have + past participle	Past	To show that something is too late / a past regret .	If I <i>had</i> known that you were in Hamburg last week, I <i>would have</i> contacted you.
Zero Conditional	If + present + comma + present	Present	To show a certainty	If you <i>add</i> salt, the sweetness <i>decreases</i> .
